



IMMIGRANTS' ROAD TOWARDS QUALIFICATION (MAMA)

The Immigrants' Road towards Qualification is a vocational education and training programme intended for immigrants, who aspire to continue their vocational studies in order to find employment.

Who is this training for?

The training is for you, if you

- already know what you want to do in the future,
- need to strengthen your Finnish language and working life skills and
- want to achieve basic vocational qualification and find a job.

What is the goal?

- You will learn vocational Finnish of your field and get information about the Finnish working life.
- You will complete one study unit of the basic vocational qualification in your field of interest.
- After the studies you will have a good chance to continue vocational education and complete the entire basic qualification.

Duration and place of studies

- Duration of studies is 7 months. The studies may continue in spring 2023.
- Studies begin on 12 September 2022.
- Group size is 10 - 15 students.
- Studies begin in Presidentintkatu 3, Kuopio.
- The place of studies may change during studies.

When you apply, you will have a language test and an interview in order to assess whether your language skills are sufficient for studies in your field of interest. Different vocational fields have different language skills requirements. There may be other sector-specific requirements as well.

Content of studies

PART 1: Studies supporting learning skills (3months)

- Vocational Finnish
- Other studies supporting learning skills
- On-the-job learning (6 weeks)

PART 2: Vocational studies (4 months)

- You will complete one whole, or a part of, study unit of a full vocational qualification.
- You will study together with other students in the same vocational field.
