



## SITE FACILITIES OPERATIVE, TRAINING FOR IMMIGRANTS (KUOPIO)

### What does a site facilities operative do?

#### Site facilities operative

- cleans, disinfects, controls, packs and sterilizes medical and research instruments
- works in the facilities operation centre of a hospital or research institution
- works together with various professionals
- ensures that instruments do not pose an infection risk
- enjoys working with customers
- works in shifts, mostly evening shift (morning, evening and night shift).

### What will I study?

Basic qualification in cleaning and property services, site facilities operator (180 competence points)

#### Vocational qualification units (145 competence points)

- Cleaning and disinfecting instruments to prevent infections
- working in the packaging process of instruments
- Sterilization as a part of infection prevention
- Elective qualification units

#### Common qualification units (35 competence points)

- Communication and interaction skills
- Mathematics and science competence
- Social and working life competence

### How will I study?

- You will study at school, online and in a work place.
- The school days are between 8 am and 4 pm.
- When you study in a workplace, you will work in shifts. Your shifts will be mostly evening shifts.
- Your work place may be outside Kuopio, too.

### Where will I study?

Savo Vocational College, Mikrokatu 1, U block, Kuopio

### What is the time of training?

- Training takes 2-3 years.

### Which language level is required?

- Language level A2 is required.
- You can prove your language skills with a certificate of proficiency or a language test.

### What are the health requirements?

- You must be in good health to study site facilities operations.
- You cannot be selected, if you have, for example
  - severe depression
  - musculo-skeletal disorders, such as back pain
  - chronic eczema
  - substance use disorder.
- Your health and functional capacity will be assessed before you start your studies.
- You must have the vaccinations required in the Infectious Diseases Act.

### How much does the training cost?

Studying is free of charge, but you will have to pay for the cost of study materials yourself.

### How can I finance my studies?

- If you apply via a continuous admission process, you can apply for Kela's financial aid for students.
- If you apply for labour force training, you can apply for unemployment allowance.
